

THINK OUTSIDE

DIY Pumpkin Bird Feeder

Supplies:

- Pumpkin
- Spoon
- 4 Sticks
- 6 ft. Twine
- Bird food

Directions:

- 1) Cut your pumpkin in half. Scoop out the seeds and core of the pumpkin with a spoon.
- 2) Poke four holes in the pumpkin with a sharp stick or skewer (see photo). Push the sticks inside the holes as resting spots for birds.
- 3) Cut the twine into two 3 foot pieces. Tie the two pieces of twine in the middle and layout to form an "x" shape.
- 4) Center the pumpkin on top of the "x".
- 5) Wrap each string around the sticks to hold the pumpkin in place. Then tie all four ends together and hand your feeder.
- 6) Place your bird food inside the bird feeder and enjoy your drop-in friends!
